





MICHELANGELO'S ORIGINAL *PIETÀ* IN PURE SILVER Michelangelo, 1475-1564 Cast by Foundry Michelangelo, one of one, 71" x 78"

This sculpture is currently the largest Pure Silver Sculpture in the world at 20,021 troy oz of .999 Pure Silver. Posthumous Original created with certified approval from Casa Buonarroti, the foremost authority and manager of the Michelangelo Estate; and Foundry Marinelli, where the original molds from the Vatican masterpieces are held. *The Pietà (1498–1499) is a work of Renaissance sculpture by Michelangelo Buonarroti, housed in St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican City.*



MADONNA DEL PASSEGGIO *Raphael, 1483-1520*

The title means the 'Madonna of the Promenade' and was an interpretation of Mary and the Christ Child appearing to have met the infant John the Baptist while walking through the countryside as Joseph looks on from the middle distance. The scene recalls popular stories of John the Baptist's youth, in which he and

Christ first meet as children when the Holy Family is returning from Egypt. The young John's animal skin tabard and wooden cross refer to his adult roles as preacher in the desert and baptizer of Christ. His paintings have sold for up \$47.8 million.

This painting was found in a former nazi bunker on the border of Poland and Germany, and has been restored by experts.



JESUS CHRIST Titian, 1488-1576

A depiction that shows a crucified Christ with the crown of thorns still on his head. The lack of a halo, and the darkness of the image suggests that he is deceased and still entombed prior to his resurrection. Titian was the greatest painter of 16th-century

Venice, and the principal painter to the imperial court. His paintings have sold for up to \$16.9 million.

This painting was found in a former nazi bunker on the border of Poland and Germany, and has been restored by experts.

A bronze limited edition bust of Mary from Michelangelo's original *Pietà*, will be auctioned off to support the Music Conservatory of Coeur d'Alene. This bust from *Pietà* is Michelangelo's only sculpture with his personal signature.


BRONZE WILDLIFE COLLECTION
